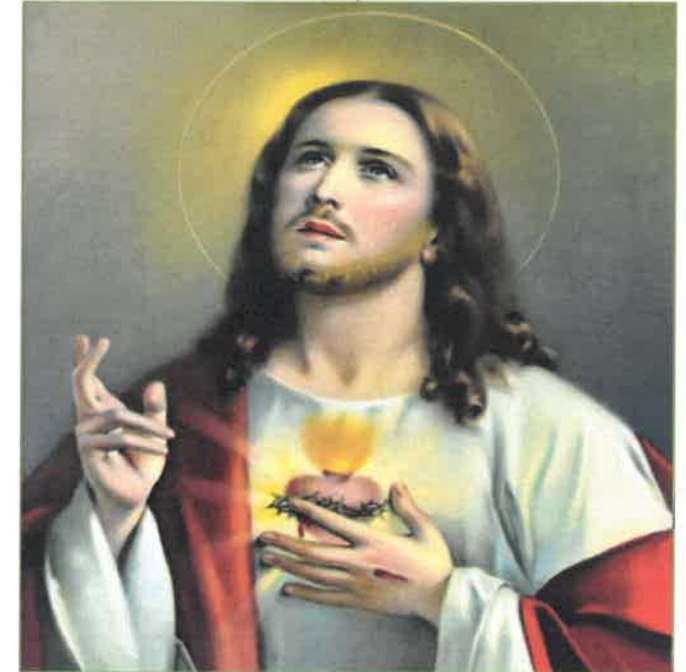
ALLELUIA, ALLELUIA
