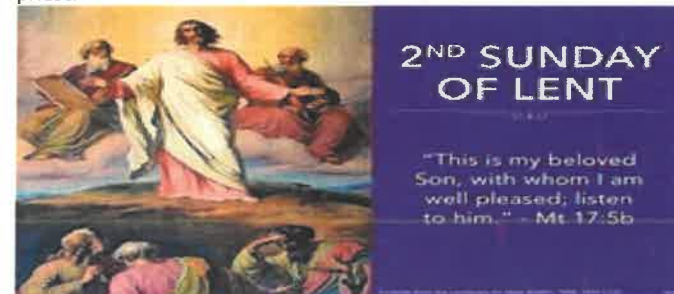
Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator

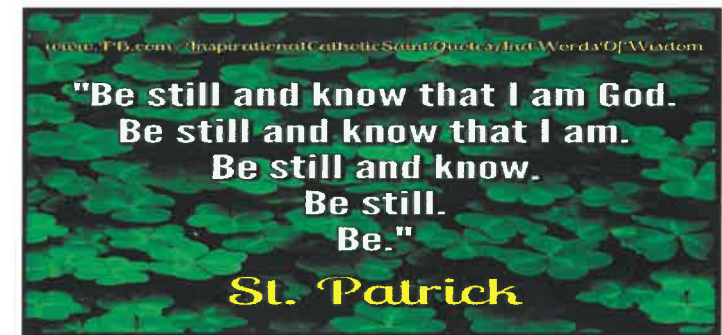
